<u>Discussion of Pre-Licensure Petition Approval</u> Chuck Thompson and Kelli Kersey

Act 990 -- regarding background checks and criminal history checks. Part of Act 990 is that an applicant for licensure may ask for a waiver to get licensed.

Many waivers are coming from Arkansas Department of Correction, who has a cosmetology and barber school. People may have time left on their sentence at the time of the waiver request. The waiver request is not a permanent denial; can be looked at again.

Discussion of the potential for possible recusal by committee members.

Waiver approval needs to done at CTAC level. Chuck Thompson makes the determination if a waiver is needed. Then it goes to Kelli, then to the committee for a decision. Committee members will receive packets for their review. Kelli will make a prelicensure petition presentation on this subject in the future.

The change in this act is that previously it only applied to crimes committed while having a license; now Act 990 is broader.

<u>Program Updates</u> Kelli Kersey

Body Art - will take rules to board of health on Thursday.

Close to getting body art and massage therapy into the CLIPS system. This will improve efficiencies in the system.
