NURSE Corps

Offers loan repayment and scholarships to nurses who work in health centers, rural health clinics, hospitals, and other facilities experiencing a critical shortage of nurses.

NURSE Corps **Scholarship** Program



Covers the entire cost of nursing school.



One-year service commitment in an eligible critical shortage facility for each year of scholarship support (with a minimum two-year service commitment).

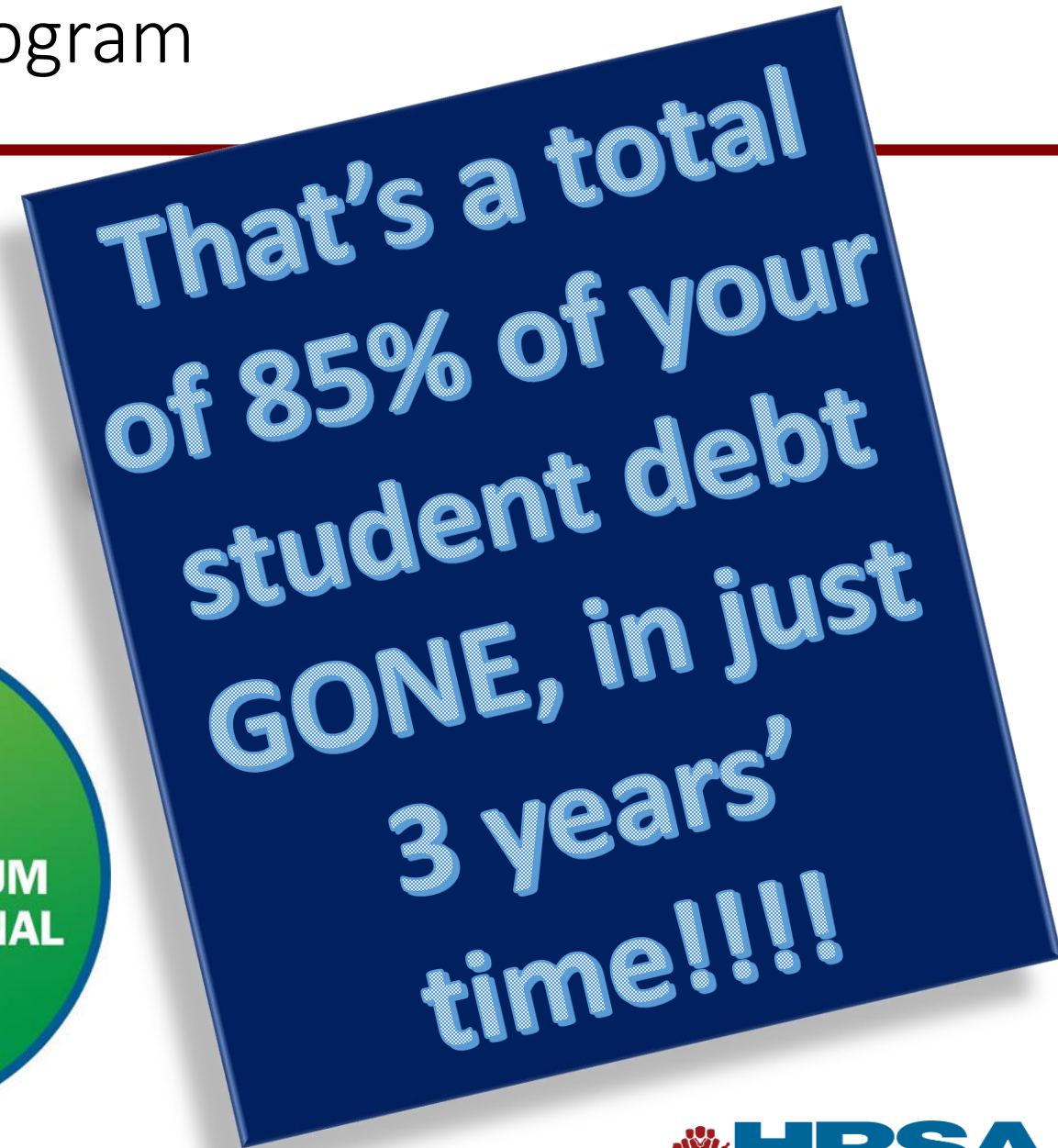

NURSE Corps Loan Repayment Program

- Pays 60% of the outstanding loan balance for all awardees in exchange for 2 years of service.
- For an optional third year of service, participants may receive an additional 25% of their original, qualifying loan balance.

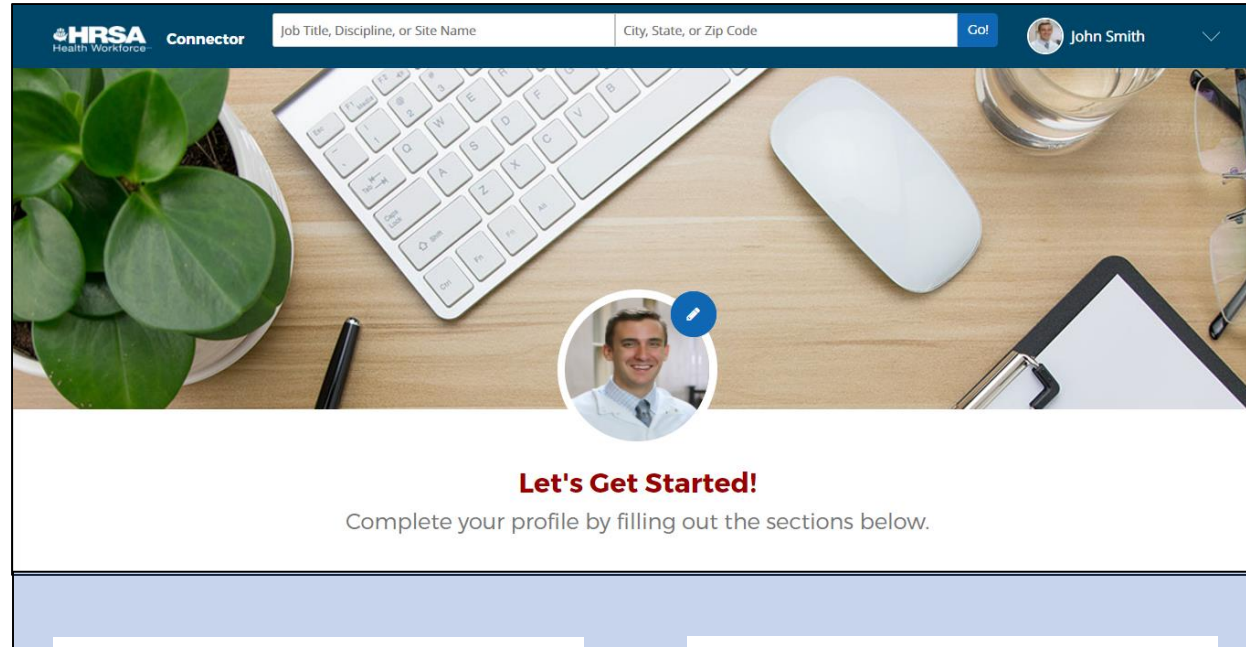
