

## Mercury in Fish Advisory Removed for Lake Monticello (Drew County)

<b>What?</b>	Mercury in Fish Advisory has been lifted and removed for all largemouth bass, blue catfish, and flathead catfish caught and/or consumed from Lake Monticello.
<b>Where?</b>	Lake Monticello, Drew County, Arkansas
<b>When?</b>	Effective July 2011
<b>Why?</b>	<p>Arkansas Game &amp; Fish Commission, Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality, and Arkansas Department of Health have collected, sampled, and analyzed fish samples from Lake Monticello.</p> <p>The Arkansas Department of Health has determined that the sampled fish from Lake Monticello no longer contain mercury at concentrations above levels of public health concern. Consumption of fish caught in Lake Monticello is considered safe.</p>
